**Description of the Proposed Project [24 CFR 50.12 & 58.32; 40 CFR 1508.25]:**

This is an on-going housing improvement activity that provides deferred payment loans to low and moderate income homeowners, as well as owner occupied duplexes and renter occupied units, who are unable to cover the cost of needed repairs. Activities may include repairs, upgrades, handicap modifications, etc., to owner-occupied homes, as well as homes acquired through this program for the purpose of neighborhood stabilization, removal of blight, or part of a neighborhood initiatives plan. This program benefits both the property owners, by improving their living environment, as well as benefiting the neighborhood by eliminating blighting conditions. The program also expands the City's affordable housing stock for LMI households, both owner occupied and rental units, as well as stabilize and improve older and LMI

neighborhoods. Funds will also be used to acquire homes in need of repair, make needed repairs and sell the homes to qualified homebuyers.

This project also utilizes program income from repaid loans. A Tier 2 Environmental Review will be completed for each individual rehabilitation project and be kept on file with the Department of Community Development.

**Approximate size of the project area:** The program places emphasis on rehabilitation of homes in low and moderate income census tracts and block groups (see maps on following pages), neighborhoods with approved plans, and is available city-wide to low and moderate income households based on HUD income limits.



for Clean Air Act's National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) \*








# Wisconsin Endangered and Threatened Species Laws & List

PUBL-ER-001 2004  
REV. June 2015



## Definitions

**Wisconsin Endangered Species:** Any species whose continued existence as a viable component of this state's wild animals or wild plants is determined by the Department to be in jeopardy on the basis of scientific evidence.

**Wisconsin Threatened Species:** Any species which appears likely, within the foreseeable future, on the basis of scientific evidence to become endangered.

## State Laws

**Endangered and Threatened Species Laws (State Statute 29.604 & Administrative Rule NR27)**

**Animals** - It is illegal to take, transport, possess, process or sell any wild animal that is included on the Wisconsin Endangered and Threatened Species List without a valid permit.

**Plants** - No one may process or sell any wild plant that is a listed species without a valid permit. On public lands or lands you do not own, lease, or have the permission of the landowner, you may not cut, root up, sever, injure, destroy, remove, transport or carry away a listed plant without a permit. There is an exemption on public lands for forestry, agriculture and utility activity.

**Permits** - No one is exempt from these laws, but an Endangered or Threatened Species "Scientific" Permit or an Incidental Take Permit can allow you to conduct certain activities under specified conditions. The Department of Natural Resources may issue these permits, under specified terms and conditions to take, transport, possess, or export listed endangered or threatened species. Permit information and applications are available from the Bureau of Natural Heritage Conservation (address below).

## Violations

**Endangered and Threatened Animals:** If the state law is violated unintentionally, the violator is subject to a fine of no less than \$500 and no more than \$2,000 and the court shall revoke all hunting privileges for one year. If the law is violated intentionally a person may be fined no less than \$2,000 and no more than \$5,000 or may be imprisoned for 9 months, or both. The court shall revoke all hunting privileges for three years.

Violations of Federal Laws will result in additional penalties.

**Endangered and Threatened Plants:** If the state law is violated unintentionally, the person in subject to a fine of \$1,000 or less. If the law is violated intentionally, the person is subject to a fine of \$1,000 or less and/or 9 months imprisonment.

The Bureau of Natural Heritage Conservation formulates management plans to aid the recovery of listed species. DNR resource managers put the plans to work in the field, while conservation wardens enforce laws protecting endangered resources.



This version of MyWATERS Mapper depicts the status of NPDES permits for each State; summary information from the Clean Watershed Needs Survey; and water quality assessments. Future versions will include other Office of Water Program Snapshots. MyWATERS Mapper also contains water-related geographic themes such as 12-digit watersheds, the national stream network known as the National Hydrography Dataset, and other water-related map layers. MyWATERS Mapper enables you to create customized maps at national and local scales.






