- They will be planted and maintained by the City of Oshkosh's Forestry Division.

How To Get Started

Make it fun, but get organized!

- Select a Neighborhood Captain to motivate and communicate with the entire neighborhood.
- Work hand-in-hand with the City's Forestry Division to establish the project's scope, species and location selections, and Spring or Fall planting dates.
- Collect tax-deductible payments from participating neighbors for all trees prior to planting.
- Consider a neighborhood planting party. Make it an event so the entire neighborhood gets involved! The more neighborhood involvement, the greater your project's priority will be with the Forestry Division.
