1. NO GARBAGE OR RECYCLING COLLECTION ON JULY 4TH: Due to the City's observance of the Independence Day holiday, there will be no garbage or recycling collection on Friday, July 4, 2025. Collections for the remainder of the week will be one day later. Garbage and recycling collection scheduled for Friday, July 4th, moves to Saturday, July 5th. Regular services will resume on Monday, July 7th.

Additionally, the City's yard waste drop-off site located on West 3rd Avenue (between Idaho Street and Ohio Street) will be closed for the holiday on Friday, July 4th. The drop-off site will reopen on Saturday, July 5th.

Residential curbside brush collection for July will take place on the regularly-scheduled garbage collection day the week of July 7th thru July 11th.
