

FAQ for November 3, 2020 Election

1. When will we be receiving ballots for the November Election?

Mailing of ballots will begin late September.

2. How can individuals/voters submit a request to receive an absentee ballot?

There are a few ways to request an absentee ballot:

- Complete the Absentee Ballot Request Form - [Link to Absentee Ballot Request](#)
- You may also request one on myvote.wi.gov
- All registered voters will receive an invitation in the mail to vote absentee from the Wisconsin Elections Commission, please complete the form and mail back to the Wisconsin Election Commission address.
- When the City Clerk's Office receives the absentee request along with a copy of the voters photo ID, staff will process the paperwork and mail out a ballot to the address indicated.

You may drop your completed absentee request form in the drop box located at the entrance of City Hall (215 Church Avenue)

3. If I voted in the August Election by absentee ballot will I automatically receive an absentee ballot for the November Election?

Only if you requested to vote via absentee for both elections.

You can view and manage your absentee ballot request on myvote.wi.gov or you may contact the City Clerk's Office (920-236-5011) to inquire if you do not have access to a computer.

4. I received multiple absentee ballot request forms, which one can I use?

You may have received multiple applications, postcards or forms to complete as your absentee ballot request, we accept all of them. only complete one

5. Can I drop my ballot off somewhere?

Once completed you may drop the sealed envelope containing your ballot in the drop box located at the entrance of City Hall (215 Church Avenue).

6. Will there be other opportunities to vote?

You may vote early In Person Absentee Voting starting October 20th – October 30th from 8:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m., location TBD; as we get closer to the start date, please check our website at <https://www.ci.oshkosh.wi.us/CityClerk/Elections.aspx>
