Notice of Public Comment Period & Public Hearing
City of Oshkosh
2026 CDBG Program Year

The City of Oshkosh will hold two public hearings and public comment period to obtain public comments pertaining to the City's 2026 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Annual Action Plan to be submitted to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The thirty (30) day public comment period will be held from 12:00 pm Wednesday, May 13, 2026 through 12:00 pm Saturday, June 13, 2026.

The first public hearing will be held at the Oshkosh Common Council meeting on Tuesday, May 12, 2026 at 6:00 pm in Room 406 of City Hall at 215 Church Avenue, Oshkosh, WI 54903.

The second public hearing will be held at the Oshkosh Plan Commission meeting on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 at 4:00 pm in Room 406 on the 4th floor of City Hall at 215 Church Avenue, Oshkosh, WI 54903.

The proposed allocations of 2026 CDBG funds as shown in the table below are tentative until the City's 2026 Action Plan is approved by the Common Council and HUD. The 2026 total program year allocation is \$817,249. A draft Action Plan is available on the City's website at oshkoshwi.gov/EconomicDevelopment/, then click on the link under News and Updates.
