

## 2026 BENEFITS ADDENDUM NON-REPRESENTED PART-TIME EMPLOYEES

Regular part-time is defined as regularly scheduled to work every week of a calendar year and accumulating 1,200 or more hours per year. This is the minimum standard for part-time benefit eligibility.
