Membership:

All residents that lie within the above stated boundaries are eligible for membership in the NorthShore Neighborhood Association. Membership is on a voluntary basis and there are no dues or fees to belong.

Fundraising:

There are no fees or dues required for membership in the NorthShore Neighborhood Association. Donations and grants are accepted and fundraising is encouraged and monitored by the steering committee. All monies raised will be used to pursue the goals of the NorthShore Neighborhood Association.

Leadership:

The NorthShore Neighborhood Association is led by a steering committee consisting of a minimum of five neighbors who will volunteer on a one year basis, to be extended if needed and have an interest to do so. The steering committee is to lead NSNA in its yearly endeavors for the enhancement, well-being, and improvements of the NSNA.

Meetings:

An annual membership meeting will be held each year in October. Other meetings may be called for organizing purposes. All NorthShore Neighborhood Association members are eligible to vote on all matters brought before the association. Decisions are to be made by consensus, whenever possible, and to be made by those present.
