Organization Governing Rules Woodland Park Association

(Referred to as WPA)

The purpose of WPA is to improve the quality of life of the residents within the Woodland Park neighborhood, promote their common interests in the neighborhood and enhance the spirit of community.

The geographic area of WPA is Greenwood Court south to East Murdock Avenue, and Hazel Street west to Bowen Street in the City of Oshkosh.

WPA is open to all those who have an interest in improving the spirit of community. Voting is reserved for residents of the Woodland Park Association.

WPA is led by a steering committee consisting of five neighbors appointed and confirmed annually. The steering committee is to lead WPA in its yearly endeavors for the enhancement, well-being and improvements of the WPA.

Contributors, contracts, grants, subscriptions and fund raising activities may be developed, arranged and monitored by the steering committee through appointed task forces to develop financial resources.

It is by consensus of those attending the meeting on May 1, 2014 held at Emeline Cook Elementary School, 1600 Hazel Street, Oshkosh, Wisconsin that these organizational governing rules are adopted.
