The City of Oshkosh has an Exemption Service (ES) program to assist residents with disabilities. Residents who are physically unable to place their carts at the curb, and have no one in their household or employ that can help, may qualify for the City's ES program at no additional cost. Residents shall submit an annual application, verified by their doctor, stating the nature of the disability that restricts them from moving their carts to the curb. Applications for the ES program are available by calling the Sanitation Division at (920) 232-5383.
