Winter ice skating returns to Menominee Park

The outdoor rink will be open, weather permitting, Saturdays and Sundays from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. in Menominee Park Zoo through February. The outdoor rink nestled in the heart of Menominee Park promises to be a magical winter attraction. The Lake Fly Café will serve as a warming shelter, and weekend skate hours will remain open as conditions permit. On the weekend, free skate rentals from Dr. Eric’s Skate Club will be available to the public.

The public is welcome to skate on the rink in conjunction with the extended Menominee Park Zoo hours of Monday-Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The warming shelter and free skate rentals will not be available on weekdays.
